Our Role

- Cover villages of Ashmansworth and Crux Easton.
- Lowest level of democracy.
- Provide guidance on Planning Applications.
- A link to Borough and County Councils on what is planned and what we want.
- Focus of local interest.
- Non-political.
- One of the smallest in the county, limited budget.
- Thanks to all members for their hard work!

What do we do?

- We meet every ~8 weeks, back to 7 physical meetings in the village hall after Covid.
- We had 6 new Planning Applications in last year.
 Of these, 5 were approved and 1 is still pending.
 Also 6 tree applications approved.
- We went out to tender for grass cutting
- We now have separate email addresses for council business.
- Village details on new improved Website.

What more do we do?

- Ashy-PC very popular, allowing any <u>member</u> to email everyone – no spam!
- Lengthsman repaired stiles, cleared footpaths and cut hedges. Need more tasks for this year.
- We replaced the defibrillator battery and ordered an additional one for the lower end of Ashmansworth
- Budget to spend our Precept to benefit Parish.
- We welcome Yuliya Tychkivska and family who have joined us from Ukraine. We keep in touch with Svitlana, Kristina and Kiril who have moved to Newbury.

Concerns and Progress

- Biggest concerns have been due to roads.
- Our section of the A343 has at last had its potholes repaired but closure of the A343 caused chaos.
- Little advance warning or diversions in place, resulting in damage and gridlock on our narrow roads
- Propose to update our Emergency Plan with action plan for road closures and share this with Highways.
- The Drove at Crux Easton has become impassable except to high clearance vehicles. We have been complaining about this since 2016 and is now <u>urgent!</u>
- Flooding at Zell Farmhouse in recent storm.

Queen's Platinum Jubilee

- We had a most memorable celebration of Her Majesty's Platinum Jubilee with a Street Party with Hog Roast, children's party, entertainment.
- We were deeply saddened by her death later in the year.
- We celebrated the accession and coronation of King Charles III, with a brilliant party on 7 May, attended by around 200!

- £1000 County Councillor Grant for defibrillator purchase (our thanks to Cllr Thacker)
- £500 Borough Councillor Community Grant for defibrillator purchase (our thanks to Cllr Falconer)
- £500 King's Coronation Event Borough Council Grant

Financial Report

- Income greater in 2022/23 due to £1000 grant
- Expenditure slightly higher- increase in clerk salary and payroll.
- Healthy reserves
- 2023/24
 - Aim to install defibrillator
 - Usual outgoings
 - 30 hours of Lengthsman (decrease from 40 hours)

Traffic Calming in Ashmansworth

- Concern for many years about speeding in Ashmansworth, especially in central section
- Faccombe have very kindly offered to assist
- Proposal to install gates at entrance to the village
- Need to select a design and message!



Solar Panel Experiences

- We now have at least 3 houses with new panels
- These have been installed as permitted development, so no need for planning applications – except for Listed Buildings
- House owners all pleased with their installations

Manor Farm House

- 11 panels, 3.6kW inverter, 3x3.5kWh battery
- Will not work in power cut as existing generator
- Installed by "Make my House Green"



Byre Cottage

- 10 panels, 3.6kW Inverter
- Pigeon guards
- Tesla Powerwall 13.5kWh battery
- Eddi to heat water
- Works in power cut!
- Installed by <u>Auream</u> of Basingstoke
