

Tudor Tomb

To the left of the main door of the church, beneath the Gerald Finzi memorial stone, there is a Tudor Tomb containing the skeleton of a young person. The Rev. Leonard Greensides discovered the brick grave whilst he was doing research into the history of the church and, feeling that some member of the church and village should be aware of this, he removed a red tile and showed the interior to myself and my brother, Michael. The tile was quickly replaced in order to avoid deterioration of the skeleton through the elements. The Rev. Greensides informed us that he had left any papers concerning his research with other documents when he moved to Yately. As my brother has died and I have moved away I feel I should pass this information on for the benefit and interest of parishioners of Ashmansworth.
